- Place of birth
- Please provide detailed nominees qualifications for inclusion in the TJHOF. Keep in mind the information provided is generally the only source of information the selection committee will review. And finally, why should this nominee be considered for inclusion in the Tennessee Journalism Hall of Fame.
